We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2011-2012 educational progress for Oehrli Elementary. For 2011-2012, Oehrli Elementary made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously looking for research based instructional strategies to implement in the classroom to improve instruction and student achievement. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

Oehrli Elementary is the only elementary school in the Montague Area Public School District that serves 1st through 5th grade students. This year we will be in the third year of our 3 - 5 year school improvement plan which we review annually. Over the past few years we have worked hard to make sure our core curriculum is aligned with the state standards in language arts, math and science, however we are continually re-evaluating our curriculum to make sure all of the standards and benchmarks are being met. This year we will be reviewing the language arts and math curriculum and continue working to align it to the common core state standards.

Oehrli Elementary School's implementation plan is similar for all content areas. The plan originates with a curriculum mapping process. Teachers at each grade level work together to identify the benchmarks being taught and assessed within a unit or taught each month in all of the core areas. Teachers spend professional development time using companion documents to help unpack the Common Core State Standards. This helps to ensure that they have a clear understanding of what students should know, and be able to do to demonstrate proficiency in each standard and benchmark. Student assessments are then developed by teachers which allow students to demonstrate evidence of proficiency on unit benchmarks. The 2012 spring DIBELS Next composite scores show that the percentage of students scoring in the intensive range in first through fifth grade levels varies from 10%-16% with the greatest percentage of intensive students being at grade 4. Grade level percentages for students attaining benchmark, range from a low of 62% at a grade level to a high of 77%.

The 2012 winter Developmental Reading Assessment for grades 1-5 shows 61% of students were on grade level. This assessment reflects miscue analysis of each student's reading as well as their ability to comprehend text and summarize the selection in writing. Once again, our special education subgroup had the largest discrepancy.

Local essential CCSS objectives are assessed using the Delta Math universal screener three times per year. This screener measures the proficiency levels of students on the previous years essential CCSS. 79% of our first through grade students were proficient in this local assessment.

Oehrli Elementary is very proud of the participation and support of our parents and community. We have parents volunteer their time to help in the classrooms with individual students or small groups. Our parent participation rate over the past couple of years for parent teacher conferences around 87%, for both fall and spring sessions. We also have a very active parent group that helps raise funds to pay for study trips, supplies and assemblies.

I am looking forward to the start of the new school year and am encouraged by the hard work and dedication of my staff. We are proud of the fact that we have been an accredited building for the past several years making AYP and receiving a Report Card Composite Grade of an A by Education Yes. This past year we only scored a C on our Report Card Composite Grade. One reason for the reduced grade was due to increased cut scores by the state. We will work hard to improve that grade by continuing to look for ways to improve the instructional strategies used in the classroom, and focus on our Title I and Special Education students that struggle academically. We take pride in our school and the work we do to ensure that all students will learn what is being taught so no child will be left behind.
