### What is the Safe Routes to School Initiative?

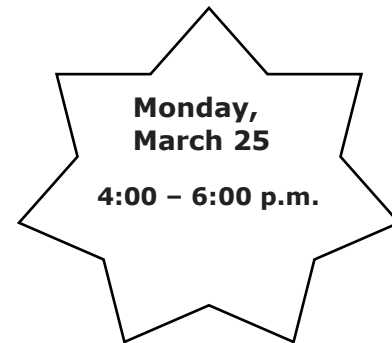
MAPS is collaborating with the City of Montague on the Safe Routes to School initiative. If approved for a Safe Routes to School grant, improvements and additions to our local sidewalk infrastructure will be largely funded by this grant.

### What is a Walking/Biking Audit?

This is the first step in the planning process to assess the safety of routes that our students take to walk or bike to school.

### What will I be doing?

- Meet in the RRO Elementary CAT Lab at 4:00 p.m.
- Receive a short training
- Form a group, and walk or bike 6-8 blocks
- Identify safety hazards along routes to school
- Bring first-hand experience of route safety problems
- Begin to identify possible solutions to existing safety concerns
- Meet back at the school to review what we learned and make suggestions to improve walking and biking safety for our students
