Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud immediately after the closing of bids at the same location in the Board Room. Interested parties are invited to attend. Bids received after this time will neither be considered nor accepted.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a sworn and notarized Familial Disclosure Statement as well as Iran Economic Sanctions Act, both of which forms are included in the Bid Form.

All Bids may not be modified, withdrawn, or canceled for a period of sixty (60) days from the time and date of Bid receipt.

BID SECURITY / PERFORMANCE BONDS

All bidders will be required to provide bid security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid. Bid security shall be in the form of a Bid Bond, Cashier's Check, or Certified Check. This shall secure the Owner from loss or damage by reason of the withdrawal of the bid by a Bidder or by failure of the successful Bidder to enter into a contract with the Owner if his bid is accepted by the Owner.

The successful Bidder will be required to secure Performance, Labor and Material bonds for all contracts exceeding \$50,000, from a surety company having a rating A- or better, for the full amount of the Contract.
